**MEDITATION OF THE DAY: *Resting, Eating, and Drinking
in the Goodness of God***

Is not the life more than the food, and the holy more than the garment? This is a most effective argument. It is an argument from the greater to the lesser. How can someone who has given you more important things refuse you lesser things? My friend, the good God has given you life, which is more valuable than any food: far be it from him, then, to refuse you the food which sustains life. Furthermore, as Job says, he has with his own hands formed and given you a body that is more valuable than any gold-embroidered garment; therefore he will also in his kindness give you the lesser gift, namely the clothing that covers the body.

He warns us against allowing concern for temporal blessings received to cause us distress. Would that we were constantly mindful in our hearts of the still greater blessings which this most generous of fathers bestows upon us, lest being forgetful of them we be more anxious than we should about temporal goods which are so unimportant. How foolish they are who do not entrust themselves to God with full confidence in this kindest of fathers! They sow and then are fearful and anxious lest a thief steal the grain or fire consume it. How empty the things human beings worry about! If we are to dispel vain anxiety, we need to think often of the blessings God bestows on us; otherwise worry and anxiety will greatly torment us. Happy they who everywhere sing with the royal prophet, *What return shall I make to the Lord for all that he has given to me? (Ps 116:12).*

Let me go a step further, brothers. Not only has God in his goodness given us life and a body without any worry on our part—this God who, as the Apostle testifies, gives more abundantly than we ask or can understand. In addition, our Savior has given himself to us as food, so that daily we eat this holy Body and drink his blessed red Blood. Behold a pledge than which there can be no greater! And it is given so that we his children may have unlimited hope in him and may not perish through lack of trust in him. Why should we exhaust ourselves for corruptible food when we are fed at the sacred altar of the nectar – sweet food of the angels?

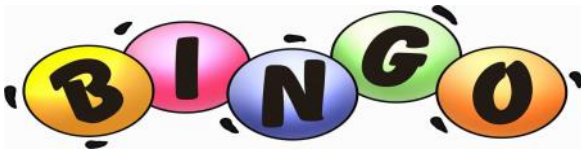
