Meditation of the Day:

How We Are Kept from the Evil One

Dear Mama: Yesterday I saw Papa. We had an excellent parlor visit! He is two inches away from the faith and a mere nothing would send him to the feet of Christ. A little time and the thing will be done. How wonderful are the ways of the Lord! I'm going to write him some more letters to direct his mind to things above, and he will not die without the grace of the Lord. May his example bring light to others and make them reflect a little on the goal of their life....

In yesterday's letter you asked me if I would want to change anything that has happened. No indeed. I have wanted you to understand this: At present, I am living through fragrant hours, certainly the most beautiful of my life; never could I have attained so close a union with

God, and without any merit on my part. It is all grace.... Soon I shall be ready to be plucked like a fragile, simple little flower. Be sure that the child Jesus, who loves small flowers, will not fail to come and pick this one to pust in his bouquet. For the present, the little flower has still to open, grow, and clothe itself in beautiful hues, so as to delight the heavenly Gardener. I await the divine dew without which I would wither, and by dint of asking for it I shall end by receiving it in abundance....

Christ has said: Father, I do not pray for the world, but for those whom you have given me (Jn 17:9). That means that the world belongs to the devil and is lost. If you seek the world, you are seeking the devil and with him your own loss. If you belong to God, you seek love and the cross of Christ. Jesus will certainly give you his cross, and this will be the plank of your salvation....There is no salvation outside of Christ crucified. Until tomorrow, dear Mama, I leave you and embrace you a thousand times.
