1st Saturday of every Month - Children's Rosary

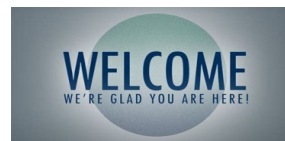
Every Saturday morning at 8:30 a.m. before the 9 am. Mass A "Scriptural Rosary for Pro Life intentions -Prayed in the Church.

“Why did you doubt”

From his monstrosity, from his tabernacle, from the depth of our hearts, he speaks to us: “For such a long time I have been with you, living by your side, coming to you daily in Holy Communion, never leaving you, being even closer than I was to my disciples. Jesus, whom we so frequently forget about, complains with a sadness that tears the heart about that which hurts him most: our ingratitude!...What a painful sword being forgotten is for the Soul who only knows how to love and to sacrifice himself in every form of martyrdom to bring happiness to those he loves!

We really do not comprehend the profound love that the Heart of Jesus has for us. The more Jesus deigns to reveal to use those secrets of his loving Heart, the more we realize that we do not understand him. His Infinite Love causes him to complain on the one hand, while our littleness inclines him to forgive us. It is only our misery that draws God toward us, because that is all that is ours. It is into this emptiness-into this nothingness-that the ocean of his goodness and the infinite love of his heart are poured.
