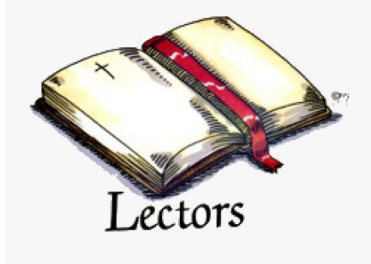

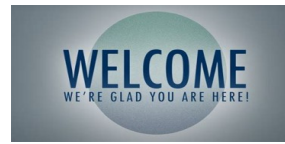

MEDITATION OF THE DAY

Offering to the Father the Consecrated One

There can be no act, prayer, or sacrifice that would be more pleasing to God and would bring more glory to him than the sacrifice of the Holy Mass. Therefore, at every Mass heaven receives more joy and pleasure from all other things or good deeds of the whole world. In all Masses Christ venerates, praises, loves gives thanks, serves, and worships the Trinity with all the power of his divinity and with all the power of his humanity, so exalted and inconceivable that his prayer of glory and thanksgiving surpasses all the prayers of angels and all the worship of saints.

We know that God created us for himself, that we came to this world to praise him, and that the Lord Jesus comes to our altars for the glory of his Father. And we know that God cannot have a greater glory than he has at the holy Mass. That is why we also cannot worship him more than by offering him the glory of Jesus Christ in the Holy Sacrifice. We see, therefore, that whoever participates in Holy Mass is present in all the mysteries of the life and Passion of the Lord Jesus. And hence this way they worship God better and obtain his graces and ensure eternal salvation more effectively. There is the source of infinite grace and sanctity.

Some people pursue temporal goods so much, while here in the Eucharist such a great treasure is hidden. Many go on pilgrimages to wonderful places, but where is a more miraculous place than the altar in the church? For those who attend Holy Mass it is as if they made all the pilgrimages, as if they were in Nazareth, Bethlehem, and Jerusalem, in the Cenacle, on Calvary, the Mount of Olives, and on Mount Tabor. For whoever participates in the Holy Mass it is as if they experienced all the miracles of the world.
