1st Saturday of every Month - Children’s Rosary

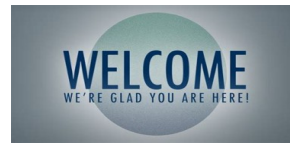
Every Saturday morning at 8:30 a.m. before the 9 am. Mass A “Scriptural Rosary for Pro Life intentions -Prayed in the Church.
